NO MATTER WHAT HAPPENS

1. _____ GOD CAN BRING GOOD OUT OF ANYTHING

"We know that <u>IN ALL THINGS (that happen)</u> God works <u>for the good</u> of those who love him and are called according to his purpose." **Romans 8:28 (NIV '84)**

"I will praise the Lord no matter what happens." Psalm 34:1a (LB)

Paul's Example:

"I want you to know, dear brothers and sisters, <u>that everything that has happened to</u> <u>me</u> here has helped to spread the Good News." Philippians 1:12 (NLT)

ANYTIME I FACE A PROBLEM WITH FAITH . . .

• IT'S A _____ TO UNBELIEVERS

"<u>Everyone here</u> (Roman prison), including all the <u>soldiers</u> in the <u>palace guard</u>, knows that I am in chains <u>because of Christ</u>." **Philippians 1:13 (NLT '96)**

• IT'S AN _____ TO BELIEVERS

"And because of my imprisonment, many believers here have <u>gained confidence</u> and been <u>encouraged to speak fearlessly</u> in telling others about Christ."

Philippians 1:14 (NLT '96)

2. NEVER LET OTHERS CONTROL MY

CRITICS: "It's true that some preach Christ out of <u>envy and rivalry</u>."

Philippians 1:15 (NIV)

COMPANIONS (who care): "Others (preach) out of <u>good will</u>. <u>These do so out of</u> <u>love</u>, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel."

Philippians 1:16 (NIV '84)

COMPETITORS: "(Others) preach Christ out of <u>selfish ambition</u>, not <u>sincerely</u>" Philippians 1:17a (NIV)

CHALLENGERS: "(Others want to) <u>stir up trouble for me</u> while I am in chains." Philippians 1:17b (NIV)

Paul's Attitude:

"But <u>it doesn't matter</u>! The IMPORTANT THING is that in every way, whether for right or wrong reasons, they are preaching about Christ! So <u>I AM HAPPY</u>, and <u>I'll</u> <u>CONTINUE TO BE HAPPY</u>!" **Philippians 1:18 (NCV)**

"Tell the good news <u>fearlessly</u>, <u>no matter what your enemies may do</u>. They will see this as a sign of their downfall, but for you it will be a clear sign from God <u>that He is</u> <u>with you</u>, and that he has given you eternal life with him." **Philippians 1:28 (LB)**

"For you have been given <u>not only</u> the privilege of trusting in Christ but also <u>the</u> <u>privilege of suffering for him</u>. <u>We are in this fight together</u>. You have seen me <u>suffer</u> for him in the past, and you know that I am <u>still in the midst</u> of a great struggle." **Philippians 1:29-30 (NLT '96)**

"<u>No matter what happens</u>, always be thankful, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus." **1 Thessalonians 5:18 (LB)**

3. _____ GOD TO ALWAYS WORK THINGS OUT

"I will continue to rejoice, <u>for I know</u> that as you pray for me and as the Spirit of Jesus Christ helps me, <u>this will all TURN OUT for my deliverance</u>."

Philippians 1:19 (NLT '96)

"It is my <u>eager expectation and hope</u> that I will not be at all ashamed, but that <u>with full courage</u>, now as always, Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death!" Philippians 1:20 (ESV)

"Do not let your <u>happy trust</u> in the Lord die away, <u>no matter what happens.</u> Remember your reward!" **Hebrews 10:35 (LB)**

4. STAY FOCUSED ON MY _____, NOT MY PROBLEM

"If <u>by continuing to live I can do more worthwhile work</u>, then I am not sure which I should choose. I'm pulled in two directions! I want very much to <u>leave this life and</u> <u>be with Christ</u>, which is a far better thing; BUT <u>for your sake</u> it is much more important that I remain alive. I am sure of this, and so I know that I will stay on with you all, to add <u>to your progress and joy</u> in the faith." **Philippians 1:22-25 (GN)**
