HOW DO I FOLLOW MY CALLING?

2 Generations as examples: Caleb & Timothy

1. BELIEVE I CAN DO IT, EVEN IF I'M

"They gave Moses this account: 'We went into the land to which you sent us, and it does flow with milk and honey! Here is its fruit. BUT the people who live there <u>are powerful</u>, and <u>the cities are fortified</u> and <u>very large</u>. We even saw descendants of Anak there. The Amalekites live there...and the Hittites, the Jebusites, the Amorites, and the Canaanites all live there!"

Numbers 13:27-29 (NIV)

"Then <u>Caleb</u> silenced the people before Moses and said, '<u>We should</u> go up and take possession of the land, for <u>we can</u> certainly <u>do it!</u>" **Numbers 13:30 (NIV)**

Caleb: "...the Lord <u>will lead us</u> into that land and will <u>give us</u> that fertile land. Don't turn against the Lord! <u>Don't be afraid</u> of the people in that land! We will chew them up. They have no protection, <u>but the Lord is with us</u>."

Numbers 14:8-9 (NCV)

2. BE WILLING TO REJECT NEGATIVE

"All the Israelites <u>grumbled</u>...and said 'If only we had died in Egypt or even here in the wilderness! Why is the Lord taking us to this country only to have us die in battle? ...Let's choose a new leader and <u>go back to Egypt!</u>" Numbers 14:2-4 (NLT)

"The whole community began to talk about stoning Joshua and Caleb!"

3. BELIEVE IT'S NEVER TOO

Caleb said: "I'm <u>now eighty-five years old</u>. I am still as strong today as the day Moses sent me out, and I'm <u>just as ready to fight now</u> as I was then. So <u>give me</u> the mountain country the Lord promised me that day long ago. Back then you heard that the Anakite(giants) people lived there and the <u>cities are large</u> and well protected." **Joshua 14:10-12a (NCV)**

DEVELOP THE GOD GAVE ME "Do not let anyone look down on you because you are young, but be an example for the believers in your speech, your conduct, your love, faith, and purity And do not neglect the spiritual gift that is in you Practice these things and devote yourself to them, in order that your progress may be seen by all." 1 Timothy 4:12, 14-15 (GN)
